

Costa Rica is one of the few countries in the world that does not have an army or military force! A peaceful place, full of great natural beauties and a pleasant atmosphere like no other.


Official language: Spanish, however, a significant percentage of the population speaks English.

Official currency: the Colón, whose exchange value is around 565 colones for 1 US dollar (exchange rate inquiries: www.bccr.fi.cr).

Costa Rica, with an extension of 51,100 km², is the home of people with a spirit full of hospitality who will happily invite you to know their country. Their capacity and social ability allows them to achieve high general progress in relation to the distribution and size of their economy.

In its territory you can enjoy a warm and pleasant climate throughout the year. The average temperature is 22 $^{\circ}$ C (72 $^{\circ}$ F) in the Central Valley, while its coasts and beaches range from 21 to 32 $^{\circ}$ C (70 to 90 $^{\circ}$ F).

This country currently has one of the highest literacy rates on the continent: close to 94% of its population. Costa Rica is the fiftieth richest country in the world according to data from the International Monetary Fund and one of the most stable countries in the Americas, well rated in all development and competitiveness indices.

PKF registration

Each country can register up to TWO (2) athletes per INDIVIDUAL category.

In TEAM categories only ONE (1) team per country may be registered.

Each country may register up to TWO (2) participants in each of the 3 official PARAKARATE categories: Intellectually Impaired Athletes, Visually Impaired Athletes.

Santiago 2023 qualifier event registration

Non-classified countries can register 1 athlete per category.

The official uniform for Referees and Coaches is mandatory at the time of registration.
